# UNFCCC: PROGRESS ON ACHIEVING GENDER BALANCE 

REPORT: Women's Participation in the UNFCCC


At UNFCCC intersessionals, women made up $43 \%$ of national delegations in 2019, compared to $32 \%$ in 2009.

In 2009, women were on average $18 \%$ of delegation heads for the four intersessional meetings.

In June 2019, 53 of the 182 delegation heads ( $29 \%$ ) were women.
