Update on PrepCom for 3rd World Conference on DRR Women's Major Group 9 July 2014

1. Meeting of the Women's Major Group
 - Tentative date 11am, July 14, Room XXVII (to be confirmed)
2. Pre-registration and access & basic info
 - Entry into the Palais des Nations on 14 July is expected to be busy. Come early and prepared (confirmation email and ID).
 - Website <http://www.wcdrr.org/preparatory/prepcom1> Find the following:
 - a. agenda, programme of work, information note
 - b. guiding questions, suggested elements, etc
 - c. concept notes on Chair's Dialogue with Major Groups, and Technical Workshops
3. Overview of sessions and expectations
 - There are three opportunities for major groups to engage during the PrepCom (see concept notes on website):
 - a. **Plenary meetings:** an opportunity to hear views from States and observers (IGOs, UN and major groups) on considerations on the post-2015 framework for disaster risk

reduction.

b. **Chairs' dialogue with major groups:** three dialogues will be held over the two days to exchange views with the co-chairs and major groups on (1) progress, good practices, innovations and lessons learned in implementing HFA; (2) reflect on the proposed elements for consideration in the post-2015 framework for disaster risk reduction; and (3) identify commitments for the Third UN World Conference on Disaster Risk Reduction.

c. **Technical workshops:** four technical workshops will be held to build further understanding on key issues, including indicators, monitoring and review process for the post-2015 framework, Investing in disaster risk reduction, and mutual reinforcement of disaster risk reduction, sustainable development agenda and goals, and climate change agreements.

- Two reports are expected to result from the first PrepCom: (1) procedural report capturing the major decisions of the meeting, and (2) a Chairs' report capturing the substance. The second report is expected to be released after the meeting.

4. Substantive documents

- The *compilation report on consultations on the post-2015 framework for disaster risk reduction* covers the consultations with governments and nongovernment organizations, regional intergovernmental organizations, United Nations and international organizations and groups (including communities, business and industry and others) during the period from March 2012 through to May 2014.

- The *suggested elements for the post-2015 framework for disaster risk reduction* drawn from the compilation report on the consultations on the post-2015 framework for disaster risk reduction. It aims to support the intergovernmental negotiations of the preparatory process for the Third World Conference on Disaster Risk Reduction. This is not a draft of the outcome document, and should not be confused with the SRSG's proposed elements paper.

Dear Colleagues,

The 3rd UN World Conference on Disaster Risk Reduction (**3WCDRR**) will take place 14-18 March in Sendai, Japan, with intergovernmental preparatory committee meetings 14-15 July and 17-18 November 2014 in Geneva. The Women's major group (WMG) will be participating in this very important process, along with the other 8 major groups, and the Women's Environment and Development Organization (WEDO) will serve as Organizing Partner to facilitate participation of women's organizations and organizations working on women and disaster risk reduction.

This message is an introduction to the process for the Third World Conference, as well as a broad call for interest in participating, particularly in the 1st PrepCom that is just weeks away!

Who should be involved? Any organization/academic institution interested in disaster risk reduction, climate change, development and humanitarian issues and interlinkages with women, women's rights, gender equality and diversity, in disaster risk reduction (DRR).

Why should you get involved? This is a 'don't miss' opportunity! This process will determine the DRR framework for at least the next 20 years and the WMG inputs and priorities will influence governments and decisions in the process towards the UN World Conference on DRR and the main outcome of the conference- Post 2015 framework for disaster risk reduction (HFA2). 2014-2015 is the opportunity to ensure that the HFA2 and Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) are gender-responsive; incorporate gender analysis and resources to support gender integration, gender budgeting; have an enhanced role for women in all their diversity to influence and implement effective strategies and instruments; make clear linkages to issues such as health, security, climate change, gender-based violence, power structures, etc; include targets and indicators for monitoring and accountability for women's participation in decision-making, gender equality and impacts and enhance resilience.
